
Who is my Local Child Health Team?

Each GP is linked to a local child health team. This consists of a GP, Specialist Paediatrician and Nurses in your local area. This provides specialist advice quickly and close to home.



Following triage, your child may be seen by a Specialist Paediatrician in a GP setting (In-reach clinic). What does this mean?

- An In-reach clinic involves a specialist paediatrician and other team members
- This is similar to a hospital appointment, but you will be seen in a local GP practice. This means you may not need to travel to hospital
- Advice is then given back to the GP. They will use this advice to treat your child.
