

# Rev. Carter Garner: The Man & The Ministry

Rev. Carter Garner is a man of faith so much, so his life reminds one of the childhood story of Thomas the Train.

Rev. Garner is the baby of 9 siblings, born at the Family home on NOV 1, 1933. He was born and raised in the historic Georgetown Section of Washington, D.C. Despite the many challenges of African American males, Rev Garner had the faith, determination and intellect to study and matriculated through STEVENS Elementary, FRANCIS Junior High School, ARMSTRONG HIGH SCHOOL, FEDERAL CITY COLLEGE as well as the WASHINGTON BAPTIST SEMINARY.

He married his beautiful and devoted wife on August 15, 1964 and have two beloved children: Ray and Elizabeth Ann, 3 grandsons: Ray, Ian and Jan Jr and 3 great grandchildren: Ireland, Chayce and Blake. He also has 3 Godchildren: Vonnell Lewis, Tiffany Padgett Johnson and Shirlene Sims Talifaro.

Rev. Garner made history working as a cartologist. He has shared many stories of how he continued to jump over the hurdles set before him to achieve his career goal. Rev. Garner would not allow the barriers to discouraged him but each day he woke up determined to meet the objectives head on.

Rev. Garner served at Park Road Community Church for many years as a Deacon and then answered the call to preach in 2003. He was licensed and ordained under Rev. Eugene W. Burton as an Associate Minister of Park Road Community Church. During his 19 years as an Associate Minister, Rev Garner has been faithful to his call of Pastoral Care.

Rev. Garner has also served on leadership boards with the International Council of Community Churches for many years. He has personally met with other clergy to inspire and encourage them to walk circumspectly in the call of Faith. He has garnered support from inactive churches and have encouraged new members to join the Council.

His ministry is a result of fruitful prayer, preparation and purpose life. There has been no assignment to small or great where Rev. Garner has not devoted his whole self to complete.

Rev. Nelson earned a master's from Capital Seminary and Graduate School of Lancaster Bible College, and a master's from Western Kentucky University. He

received a Graduate Business Certificate (Leadership Development Program) from Johns Hopkins Carey Business School. He received a certificate in Nonprofit Executive Leadership from the Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy. He has a bachelor's from Towson University.

Rev. Nelson is a graduate of Leadership Montgomery and completed the REAL Inclusion Program.

In addition to his ministry service, Rev. Nelson works for Montgomery College where he encourages skill and academic success for students, community representatives, and professionals.

In 2007 and 2010, Rev. Nelson was selected by Montgomery County's Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commemorative Committee (MLKCC) as a program participant for the annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration. He has served as president of the ICCC Ministers Group and president of the Black Minister's Conference of Montgomery County. Rev. Nelson has received several awards and appreciation for his contributions to the community. In 2018 Rev. Nelson was inducted into the Montgomery County Human Rights Hall of Fame. Rev. Nelson is married to Debra and they have four adult children.






