BE SPECIFIC IN YOUR REQUEST

Clearly define the topic or question and ensure your request is focused. What can you tell me about sustainability?

What are the best strategies for reducing environmental impacts in a sustainability-focused business?





PROVIDE NECESSARY CONTEXT

Provide background information in your prompt, including the audience, purpose, or specific angle you want addressed. These details that can guide the AI's response. Explain carbon accounting principles <u>to a non-technical</u> <u>audience.</u>





STATE THE FORMAT YOU WANT

Do you need bullet points, a summary, a detailed explanation, or a 500-word article? Provide <u>a step-by-step guide</u> on how to implement a sustainability strategy.





CLARIFY THE TONE AND STYLE

Is your piece formal, informal, technical, or conversational? What is the client's brand tone? Try 'Explain it to me like I'm 10 years old' or 'Explain it to me as if I am an expert' to help get the right tone. Write a <u>conversational</u> blog post introducing sustainable energy solutions for small businesses.





INDICATE CONSTRAINTS

What's the word count? Do you need AI to look within specific dates, or provide references? Summarize the major events in sustainable development <u>from 2020 to 2023</u> in <u>under 300</u> <u>words</u>.





ASK FOR CLARIFICATIONS OR EXAMPLES

Sometimes AI inputs give useful generalities, but you may need clarifying examples or specifics to get what you're looking for. Can you give <u>examples</u> of major events in sustainable development?

> What does 'green finance' mean in the context of international banking?





ITERATE AND REFINE

If the initial response isn't quite what you need, give feedback to guide the AI toward a more accurate answer. Be prepared to create multiple iterations. That's helpful, but can you rewrite this to <u>focus more on</u> how businesses overcame challenges to become more sustainable?

Can you <u>expand</u> on the <u>specific</u> challenges facing businesses?





ASK FOR MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES

When addressing complex or controversial issues, you can ask the AI to provide different viewpoints or approaches. This can help you see a fuller picture of a topic and avoid bias. What are the arguments for and against carbon taxes as a solution to climate change?





FACING A BLANK PAGE? ASK FOR IDEAS!

Al can help with brainstorming ideas, content creation, and creative problem-solving. These can kick-start your human thinking - even when you don't ultimately use the Al-generated output. Give me five creative social media post ideas for eco-friendly Christmas gifts.
