Last Year's Activities

Maintained 501c3 status through ParentBooster.org

Conducted the first Annual Golf Bash as a group fundraiser

Solicited corporate funds to support the expenditures of the team.

Purchased Uniform polo and long-sleeve outer layers for both Varsity girls and boys teams

Purchased Shirts and Hats for the Middle School Club members

Paid for the Windber summer membership for the Varsity Players.

Paid for the summer use of Richland Greens by the Middle School Club members. This was used a lot by some and less by others, but Richland Greens and the adults who played there while the kids were using it were complimentary and appreciated seeing kids out and playing.

Supported two summer events for the Middle School including both skill and door prizes.

Supported an end of season event with lunch and 9 holes of golf at Windber.

Paid for two events for the team to participate in and four different practice events in preparation for the Sectional and District championships.

Provided many of the golf balls for both Boys and Girls teams as the school had not ordered enough.

Fall 2026 Season Plans

May 14, 2025 – Golf Bash at Windber Country Club. All golfers/families are asked to sell two tickets.

The boosters will continue to pay for two additional events for the boys.

Support the Foundation Golf Outing – work it and support two foursomes (boys and girls), Sell greenies on #2 as before, provide door prizes.

Fund practice rounds before sectionals, districts and states.

Pay for the Middle School use of Richland Greens (8:00 to Noon, Monday-Friday)

Host two events for the Middle School at Richland Greens.

End of Season Event (Last Practice Scramble with Lunch)

Elections:

Varsity Team Plan & Expectations – JJ and Jill discussed the plans for the varsity squads and the need for summer play and competition.

- Five matches starting the week of August 17 at Windber, North Fork, Clearfield, Somerset and Sunnehanna.
- Preparation for the season begins long before August 10. Kids have the opportunity to play Windber all summer. Take advantage of that.
- Scores turned in for summer play must be attested by another team member, so play with each other.
- Integrity matters. Cheaters will get exposed, and it can cost the team. Count all your strokes. He articulated the reputation of one school who had been caught.

Jr High Golf Club Plan – Bart provided an overview of the Jr High Golf coming for this year including the following:

- This year Jr High will participate at Richland Greens.
- Club members will have the opportunity to play at Richland Greens beginning after June 2 from 8-12:00, Monday-Friday at no cost. Only those identified by Bart can play without an adult to ensure youth on the course understand the rules of the game and expected etiquette.

Budget Plan, value & Fundraising – Jim reviewed this year's budget plan

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- **Varsity** (value of \$400/player):
Golf Balls, Event entry fees and practice rounds Uniforms, Senior Gifts, Banquet, Summer Greens Fees
- **Junior High Golf Club** (value of over \$190)
Summer membership at Richland Greens – value of \$125/player
Junior High Golf Club Shirts – cost of \$50
Junior High Golf Club Hat – Cost of \$15
Clinic – Volunteer time and education – you decide

Events – About \$250 for each event

- **Fundraising**

As a result of the 501(c)3 status, we are not asking people to sell advertising, rather, we are looking for the kids to solicit tax-deductable donations as follows:

Varsity Team	\$250
Junior High	\$125

Any golfer who raises \$250 more than their goal will have the option of receiving a Richland Golf bag with their name embroidered or a Windber Pro Shop Gift Card.

We need each Varsity golfer to sell 2 Golf Bash Tickets = Only 250 available. Ticket sales will not count towards fundraising goals this year.

Fundraising goals must be submitted no later than 15 May 2026 in order to receive a second uniform item.
