How do we start the process?

We will begin with a complimentary introduction session to determine if I am the right fit for you, your home, and your pet and I will determine if your needs are the right fit for me. We will discuss all the details of my services and determine an exact fee. This session happens in person the first time and can be completed over the phone thereafter.

What do you do and how much does it cost?

Overnight Sitting Services – House and Pet Sitting. I come and stay at your home for 10-12 hours. (Between 9 pm and 9 am) If you have a dog, daytime potty services are provided at no additional charge. Rates start at \$50 per night)

Daytime Sitting Services – House and Pet Checks. I will come by and check on your house and pets for 20-30 minutes at a time. Minimum checks are required if you are out of town and have dogs and cats; this will be discussed during the complimentary introduction session. (Rates start at \$20 per visit)

Each assignment is different, but I often gather mail and papers, tend to garbage collection and adjust the lighting to give your home a lived-in appearance. I play with your pets, walk your pets, and provide love and attention to your pet while you are away. Pet care should not be complicated. I try to make it as easy on you and your pets as possible. I have been known to water plants and stock pantries; all of this will be discussed during our introduction session.

The full fee will be determined during the introduction session.

How do I pay?

For all services, a 50% non-refundable deposit is collected at the time of the introduction session to secure a booking. The remainder is due within 3 days of the scheduled booking. I accept the following payment methods: Cash, Venmo, and Zelle.

Why should I use a Sitter?

By using a sitter, you do not need to travel to the kennel to drop off and pick up your pet. Pets deal with owner absences better in the comfort of their environment. Also, the chances of your pet being exposed to illnesses are reduced if you are not placing them in a kennel. Some pets, especially cats are traumatized by car rides.
