How a veteran requests PADRECC care

1. The veteran must be enrolled in VA health care.
2. The veteran chooses a PADRECC, Associated Site or Regional Parkinson's Movement Disorder Center.
3. A VA primary care provider or neurologist submits an inter-facility consult.
4. The veteran follows up with the receiving center after at least 72 hours to schedule.
