

"Obscene Gestures" explores the contradictions of censorship controversies surrounding literary and artistic works from Richard Wright's "Native Son" and Toni Morrison's "The Bluest Eve" to works by Robert Mapplethorpe, 2 Live Crew, and others. Dr. Lawrence dives into notorious obscenity debates, revealing how these controversies impacted culture in ways that reflected racial, gender, and sexual stereotypes.
