- OPEN DISCUSSION:

- Softball Fall Ball: 6 weeks starting end of September 8th-Oct 14th no keeping score and no tournaments. Talked about piggy backing one game after another to use the same umpires. Would like umpires for Farm Minor as a mediator between coaches. Games on Sundays. For Farm Major, would like umpires due to grey area in the rules. Keystone and Buckeye were interested for Farm Minor. Elyria program would be transitioning to Farm Major, and possibly bumping them up to Farm Major for fall. Buckeye, Firelands and Keystone for Farm Major are interested. First come first serve basis for teams replying for a spot to play. Take on Ump fees since there are no other fees associated with running the program. Hour and a half or 5 innings for Farm Minor. Fees for umps would be split between teams playing. Have teams pay the ump fees up front as a registration fee. Nicole motioned to cover fees for fall ball, Mike 2nd and motioned passed *For boys, league will cover half since registration fees are more expensive.
- Fred proposed an off season program to keep things moving. Recommended one day a week.
- Nicole advised that county is looking for trustees and looking for people on the softball side.
- Helping out Oberlin this year, was rough. They had no help. If we are considering being a tournament site, we will need a lot of volunteers. Ryan is going to sit down with Oberlin and talk about working together and rotate years to hold tournament site.
- Have had a lot of kids who play in the Rodak tournament every year. Goes to a scholarship. Wants to be a sponsor of the tournament. Held at the Depot in Lagrange. \$30 per player, 4 players per team. Asking for flat \$200 to sponsor. Brittany motioned to sponsor, Ashley 2nd and motion passed.
- Re-elections are coming up, President, Softball PD, Softball VP, Concessions, Secretary, T-ball VP, Fundraising, Social Media and Field Scheduler. Need to know 2 weeks prior. October 6th will be when elections are held. September 22nd is when we need to know if you are going to run for election. October 20th will be the official vote for open board member positions.
