4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING(S) – The minutes from the January 10, 2022, regular session were presented. Motion made by Commissioner Barnes, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, to accept the minutes.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

5. PRESENTATION AND APPROVAL OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S FINANCIAL REPORT – The financial report for January 2022 was presented. A copy was provided to each Commissioner (copy attached). After review, motion made by Commissioner Barnes, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, to accept the report and approve payment of all bills and expenditures as set out therein.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

6. NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion and possible action regarding granting Chief Bodin authority to negotiate and sign an Interlocal Agreement with Orange County ESD #3 for dispatch services – Ms. Chatagnier addressed the Board. She stated she had met with representatives of ESD #3 last week. They have approximately 200 calls per year. They were requesting the line be recorded so she was going to remove the non-emergency roll-over line from the recording system and add theirs. Should be effective March 1, 2022, but would go live as soon as the radios, phones were added. After discussion, motion made by Commissioner Franklin, seconded by Commissioner Barnes to grant Chief Bodin authority to negotiate and sign an Interlocal Agreement with Orange County ESD #3 for dispatch services.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

B. Discussion and possible action regarding changing health insurance for employees – Ms. Chatagnier stated that the current provider, BCBS, did not cover prescriptions as well as the intended new plan. All employees covered had looked over the new plan and want to change. Change will be effective in April and will be an increased cost for all. After discussion, motion made by Commissioner Franklin, seconded by Commissioner Barnes, to allow the change in employee health insurance.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

C. Discussion and possible action regarding establishing an exploratory committee regarding transitioning to a day crew – Chief Bodin and Commissioner Barnes addressed the Board. Stated that due to missed calls during the day period, the upcoming expansion of Entergy plant, Chevron plant, etc., now seems the time to look into the matter. After discussion, motion made by Commissioner Barnes, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, to authorize an exploratory committee consisting of 2 board members, 2 firefighters, Chief Bodin, and Ms. Buffington.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

- 7. COMMUNICATIONS FROM CHIEF, DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, ETC. Chief Bodin stated Engine 1 at PM; burn building work ongoing at FTC. Brennan stated that 5 ton repairs almost complete prior to going to Huntsville for paint; portable generator on Reserve 1 not generating; driveway at Station 2 he's met with Ronnie Hutchison of OF Water and they still cannot find water line.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING(S) – The minutes from the June 27, 2022, regular session and the no quorum July 26, 2022, session were presented. Motion made by Commissioner Landry, seconded by Commissioner Barnes, to accept the minutes.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

5. PRESENTATION AND APPROVAL OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S FINANCIAL REPORT – The financial reports for June and July 2022 were presented. A copy was provided to each Commissioner (copy attached). After review, motion made by Commissioner Franklin, seconded by Commissioner Childers, to accept the report and approve payment of all bills and expenditures as set out therein.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion and possible action regarding review and acceptance of 2022 certified value and corresponding reports from OCAD – Ms. Buffington presented the certified value and corresponding reports from OCAD. After review, motion made by Commissioner Franklin, seconded by Commissioner Childers to accept the certified value and corresponding reports from OCAD.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

B. Discussion and possible action regarding review and acceptance of 2022 tax rates from County Tax A/C – Ms. Buffington presented the rates as calculated by Karen Fisher, Tax A/C (documents are available for review on the District's

website). After review, motion made by Commissioner Landry, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, to accept the 2022 tax rates from the County Tax A/C.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

- C. Discussion and possible action regarding tax rate for 2022
 - a. Propose tax rate
 - i. Set date for public hearing; and
 - ii. Set date for meeting to adopt budget and tax rate

Ms. Buffington informed the Board that, based upon the rates calculated by the Tax A/C, the 2022 de minimis rate is greater than the statutory maximum rate allowed by law. Therefore, she had calculated a proposed budget based upon \$0.10 per \$100 of value. Due to limitations with the Orange Leader's publication dates, she would ask that the public hearing be held June 22, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., with a Special Called Meeting to follow that same day at 6:15 p.m., at which time the Board can adopt the budget and the tax rate. After discussion, motion made by Commissioner Barnes, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, to propose a tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 of value for tax year 2022, schedule the public hearing for June 22, 2022, at 6 p.m. with the special called meeting to follow that same day at 6:15 p.m. and both meetings to be held at Station 2.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

- 7. COMMUNICATIONS FROM CHIEF, DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, ETC. Chief Bodin gave a recap of the last two months' calls and that the average response time was down; stated that all apparatus were in service; floor repairs were made to the burn building; and the lead time on new apparatus is averaging 24 months or more and Pierce is taking no new orders for commercial chassis. Brennan Dobbs stated the dispatch ceiling was still sweating and that he had talked with 2-3 HVAC people and received no new information/help; and that new generator at Central was in service.
- 8. ADJOURNMENT There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:22 p.m.

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The regularly scheduled meeting of the Orange County Emergency Services District #2 was called to order at 6:15 p.m.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 17.0316% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$14.553. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Childers.

C. Discussion and possible action regarding authorizing Chief Bodin to initiate hiring process for day-crew – District Administrator Buffington stated that Chief Bodin asked that the Board authorize him to begin the process so that he could write SOPs, etc. and come back to the Board next month with more information.
