- 1. CALL TO ORDER The regularly scheduled meeting of the Orange County Emergency Services District #2 was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

- 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS The following guests were in attendance: Chief Bodin; Asst. Chief Taylor; Brennan Dobbs; and Becky M. Buffington, District Administrator.
- 4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING(S) The minutes from the March 24, 2025, regular session were presented. Motion made by Commissioner Childers, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, to accept the minutes.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

5. PRESENTATION AND APPROVAL OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S FINANCIAL REPORT – The financial report for March 2025 was presented. A copy was provided to each Commissioner (copy attached). After review, motion made by Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Childers, to accept the report and approve payment of all bills and expenditures as set out therein.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

6. NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion and possible action regarding possible sales tax election - appointing committee members and discuss retaining Touchstone District Services to assist in public relations, e Discussion and possible action regarding approving contract to retain Touchstone District Services to assist with possible sales tax election – Ms. Buffington presented the written contract from Touchstone. After review, motion made by Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Childers, to approve same.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

B. Discussion and possible action regarding adoption of TCDRS 2026 plan rate – Ms. Buffington stated that she recommended the Board retain the required rate for 2026, which will be 10.48%, down from 10.62% for 2025. After review, motion made by Commissioner Childers, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, to adopt the required rate of 10.48%.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

C. Discussion and possible action regarding adoption 2025 residence homestead exemptions (homestead, 65 or older & disabled) – Ms. Buffington informed the Board that in prior years, they had voted to grant exemptions of \$15,000 for OA and disabled and \$0 for homestead. After discussion, motion made by Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Childers, to adopt \$15,000 for OA and disabled and \$0 for homestead.

All voted AYE. Motion carried.

- 7. COMMUNICATIONS FROM CHIEF, DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, ETC. Chief Bodin stated Engine 1, which is 12 years old has frame corrosion so extensive thah the manufacturer is not sure what to do at this point. The 50-year frame warranty excludes corrosion so we may have to make some hard decisions. ISO ratings back City and outside with but within 1000' of a hydrant received a "4". Items where points lost mostly easy to upgrade. Mr. Dobbs stated that PMs are being done and he is making materials available to save money where he can; storage facility buildings have been ordered. Concrete guy has been brought in to pour for piers and look at hole in front of bay where Unit 9 parks. Should have contract for Televon by next meeting.
