**A Visit With Dr. John**

Final transactions were completed yesterday, July 6, for the purchase of the land and house between the Vineyard property and the paved road. I appreciate Steve and the Vineyard Committee chaired by Viola Shaffer.

In accord with long-range goals, they helped the association become aware of the opportunity to acquire the property and have led in making sure the appropriate committees signed off on the transaction. They made all the connections with the owner/seller and took care of all the details.

For several years, the Vineyard Committee has wanted to build a RV park. Quite a few people may want to make use of it, but the primary idea was to have it for use by groups like Campers on Mission. People in this organization already have rendered much assistance to the work at the Vineyard. RV hookups likely will ensure the presence of these volunteers for more than just a few weeks out of the year.

The problem we have faced is that the majority of our property is on the low side of the creek. Just about all that area is floodplain. It doesn't flood often, but it does on occasion. The property just purchased is on the high side of the creek. It will provide a great spot for RVs.

Besides that, the Committee has seen value in owning all of the property on the creek side of the dirt road to the paved highway. That has been a part of the dream for Vineyard workers and volunteers for a couple of decades.

The owners were asking about \$190,000 for the property. They came down to \$160,000. If your church would like to help pay for the property, it would be much appreciated. Some churches may want to receive an offering to help pay for the property on one day or across several weeks. Other churches may just want to designate a certain amount out of their general fund. Any way you do it will be fine. We just want to make sure you have the opportunity to share in the continued building of this great camp owned by the churches of Coffee Baptist Association.

Our Lord surely has blessed our cooperative work at the Vineyard. So many people have been saved and disciplined there. So many people have given money and their time and effort to make it a success. God grant that it will continue its wonderful ministry and that its work may prosper even more in the years ahead!
