When you order your nuc(s) by phone, via email, in person or by mail you agree to the following policies, contract terms, conditions, limitations and exceptions with the Nicaragua Bee Project, Inc.

We make every attempt to have your bees ready for pickup during the weekend of April 20, 2019 in Waupaca, Wisconsin. However, the production of nucs and queens is dependent on factors which lie outside our control, including weather patterns.

As a result, the Nicaragua Bee Project may need to rearrange scheduled dates or make other accommodations. The Nicaragua Bee Project will provide notification to you via email, phone call, or postal mail if this situation occurs to minimize the inconvenience.

We do not refund any money for nucs that do not arrive on a schedule date as long as an alternative date is provided.

A Health Certificate is provided with every Nicaragua Bee Project nuc order. However, this does not guarantee that you will be able to successfully establish a colony or "hive" with your nuc.

You agree that you will not attempt to hold us responsible for whatever may happen to your nuc after it is picked up, or for the survival or productivity of the hive that you may establish from the nuc(s).

We do not refund any money for nucs that do not survive.

There is a potential risk of injury from activities involved in beekeeping, and while particular rules, equipment and personal care may reduce this risk, the risk of injury does exist: and you knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence of the releases, and assume full responsibility for your participation; and hereby release and hold harmless the Nicaragua Bee Project, their officers, other participants, and the owners of the premises (releasees) used to conduct this sale event, with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, to the fullest extent of the law, whether arising from the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
