

# Pine Hills Men's Club 2020 <>Year End Two Man Scramble

## RULES OF PLAY

NOTE: All play is from the **BLUE** tees and handicaps are calculated from the **BLUE** tees

- 1) On every hole, each team member hits his tee shot from the **BLUE** tees. Each team member must use at least 1 tee shots on the front nine and 1 tee shots on the back nine.
- 2) The team then selects the ball to play. Mark the position of the selected shot with a tee or ball marker. Both players hit from that position as follows:
  - a. Each team member may improve his lie by placing the ball with his hand, or by moving it with the club head, within one club length of the marked position, no nearer to the hole. Ball may be lifted, cleaned and placed.
  - b. Team members may hit in any order, and are permitted to stand behind one another (on an extension of the line of play) while they are hitting a shot or putt.
  - c. **FAIRWAYS, ROUGH & HAZARDS** - Each team member must place his ball within one club-length of the marked position, no nearer to the hole. If the selected shot is played from a hazard or in the rough, both players must play within the hazard or rough. Also a ball selected that is in the fairway, it must be played from the fairway. Smooth and place rule applies in bunkers for both team members.
  - d. **FRINGE OF THE GREEN** - If the selected shot is on the fringe of the green, the ball must be placed within a few inches and no nearer to the hole, and cannot be placed onto or closer to the putting surface.
  - e. **ON THE GREEN** - When putting, the ball must be placed within one putter head length of the marked position, no nearer to the hole or green.
  - f. **FREE DROPS** – If a shot comes to rest in an area where relief is normally permitted. Player may take his drop before the team decides which ball is going to be played.
  - g. **Holing out** -Teams are cautioned not to make tap-ins until both team members have had the opportunity to make the team's original putt. Once a ball is holed out, no further strokes are permitted to lower the score.
- 3) In the event of a tie for First Place, Sudden Death Playoff will commence beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> Hole using full team handicap on each hole.(only the pro shop can change the starting hole for a playoff) All other ties will be decided in the usual manner.

### Pine Hills Men's Club Playoffs

If both players leave the facility, they have conceded the playoff. One player can play alone in a playoff for this event. If all players tied for first leave the facility, the winner will go to the next best score, and if still tied the USGA tie breaker system will be used.
