CLUB RULES

ALL U.S.G.A. RULES APPLY

The rules committee will post local rule changes and exceptions for any day it is warranted. It is the player's responsibility to know the rules and follow all postings. Any disputes, problems, or questions must be addressed to the rules committee immediately upon completion of play.

SCORER

The scorer is the player, usually the cart driver who scores of others in the group. It is his responsibility to record the scores verbally told to him. The scorer is not a referee, but if he knowingly records a wrong score and fails to report it, for any player, both the player and the scorer will be disqualified. A completed, legible, and attested score card is expected to be turned in at the completion of play.

POSTING

Scores must be posted on the score board. It is the responsibility of the team or player to post their on the board, <u>not</u> <u>the scorer</u>

Kickers and Skins must be posted on the board.

Non-posted Skins or Kickers will not be paid.

TIES

In the event of ties, matching of scorecards is used except in major events. As suggested in the rules of golf, the winner is determined on the basis of the best score (net) for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same last nine holes, the winner will be determined on the basis of the last six holes, last 3 holes, than 18th hole, than 17th hole, etc.

Founders Cup

Since this is a season long event the tie breaker will be a 3 hole playoff at 100 % handicap starting on the first hole. If still tied, Sudden death will be used. If a player or players are not available or Darkness or weather or any other reason makes a play off not reasonable Matching of cards will be used. This decision will be made by the committee.

All 1st Place Ties in Major Tournaments are Played off Sudden Death starting at the First Hole.
