GOAL 1

GOAL 2

GOAL 3

By June 2023, all BKNHS will create or expand their parent engagement plans to increase family involvement in our schools through collaboration and partnership with community stakeholders, empowering parents to be co-decision-makers and best advocates for their children's learning needs in our reimagined communities.

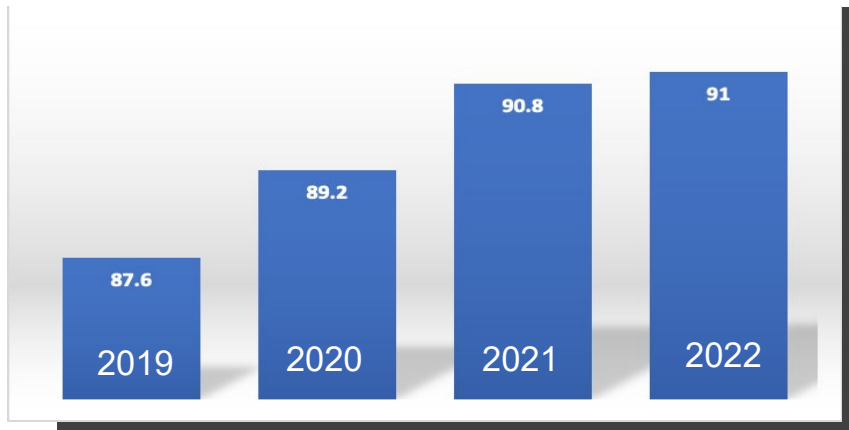


GOAL 4

District Data Trends

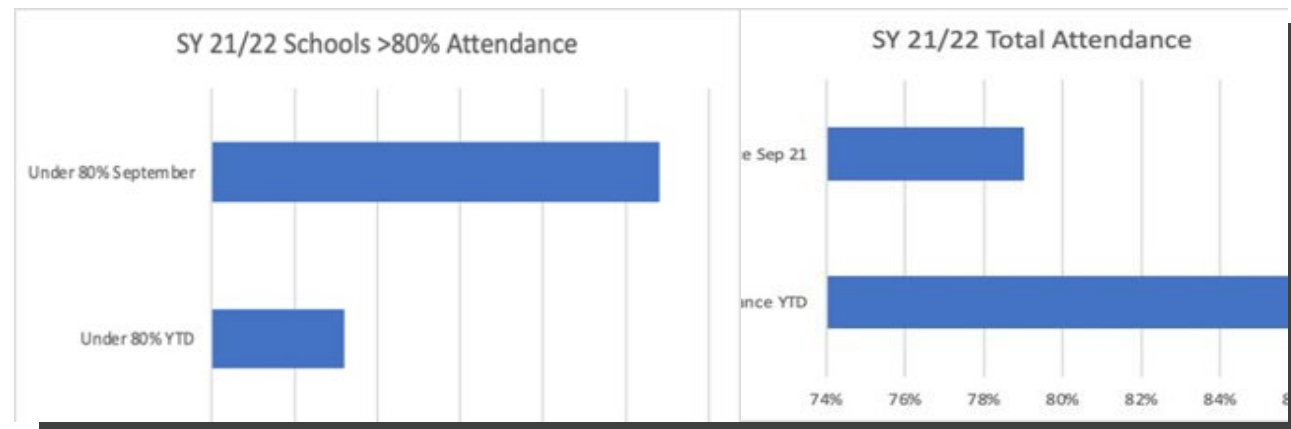


4-Year Graduation as of June 2022

40 of our 47 schools were above 80% YTD

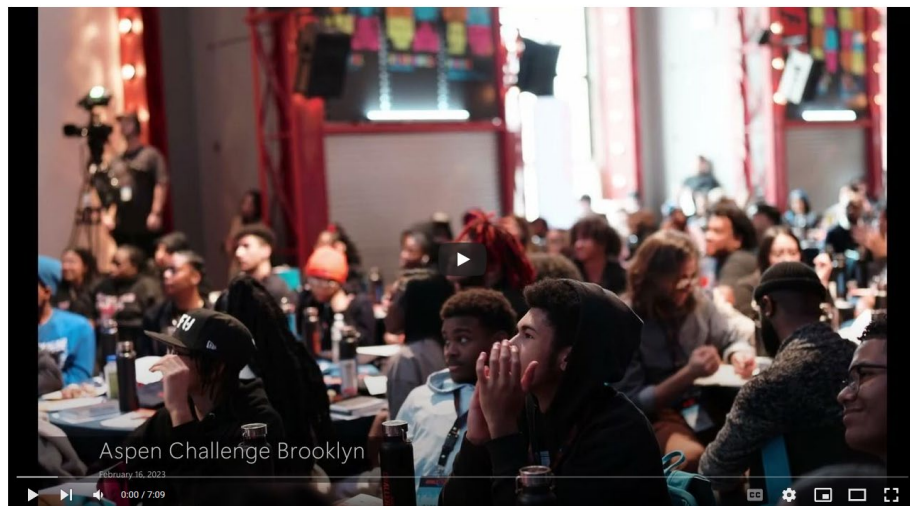

Dear Staff, Parents, and Students of the **John Jay School for Law**,

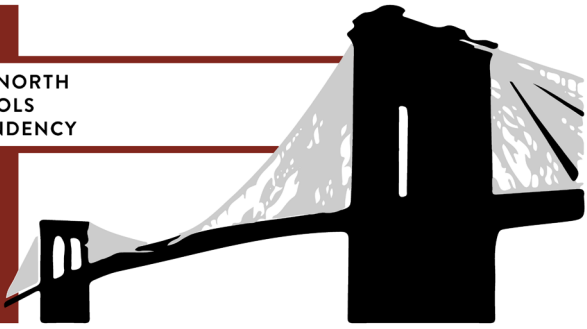
I am pleased to announce the appointment of **Shomari Akil** as Principal of the **John Jay School for Law** as of February 27, 2023.

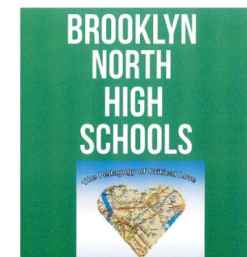
12/11/2022

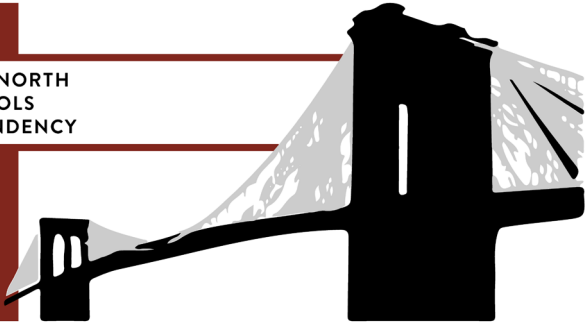
