



Looking Back ... Graduation




4-Year Graduation

Almost 4 percentage point gain since Superintendent Ross has led the district, persevering through the COVID epidemic



Looking Back ... Attendance



SY 2021-22, our district attendance improved from 79% in Sep to 86% in Jun.

As of Jun 2022, 40 of our 47 schools were above 80% YTD; 38% of students were chronically absent

Year-to-Date Average Attendance as of 1/25/2023 BKNHS District = 86% | BKNHS D15 = 84% | Citywide = 92%



Looking Forward ... Goals

By June 2023, all BKNHS will create or expand their parent engagement plans to increase family involvement in our schools through collaboration and partnership with community stakeholders, empowering parents to be codecision-makers and best advocates for their children's learning needs in our reimagined communities.

By June 2023, the **BKNHS** district chronic absenteeism rate will decrease by 5%, while overall attendance will increase by 5%, resulting from an effective and supportive attendance management system that involves school partners, structures for data monitoring and analysis, evaluation and assessment, and opportunities for meaningful stakeholder engagement.

June 2022 ELA Regents district average - 67.8%	By June 2023, the average score for all our students on the ELA Regents will increase by 3.5% points to align with the citywide average.
June 2022 MAT Regents district average – 60.5%	By June 2023, the average Algebra I score for all our students will increase by 2.5% points to align with the citywide average.
NYSED College, Career, Civic Readiness index	By June 2023, 100% of district high schools will increase their NYSED CCCR score by 2% as measured by the NYSED College, Career, Civic Readiness index.
June 2022 district chronically absenteeism = 38%	All district schools will use differentiated programming modules, engaging all students in culturally responsive and sustaining, standards-aligned instruction integrated with SEL practices to reduce chronic absenteeism by 2% by June 2023.
June 2022 - 63% of schools have a robust parent engagement plan	By June 2023, 100% of Brooklyn North high schools will have a robust parental engagement plan, as defined by Karen Mapp Dual Capacity Framework, to increase family involvement in our schools through collaboration and partnership with community stakeholders.

 - Not just ablet to get the numbers but emphasizing the importance of placing them in the path of success.








