## GOAL 1

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GOAL






## **District Data Trends**



#### 4-Year Graduation as of June 2022

In spite of the COVID epidemic, Brooklyn North High Schools under Supt Ross's leadership have consistently supported more and more students to graduate. As a result, as measured by NYSED accountability, ALL 47 of our schools have achieved "good standing" status!



#### Attendance as of June 2022

40 of our 47 schools were above 80% YTD +7 percentage points (79% Sep to 86% Jun) 38% of students were **chronically absent** 

#### As of 3/31/23, ALL 47 schools are above 80%!






