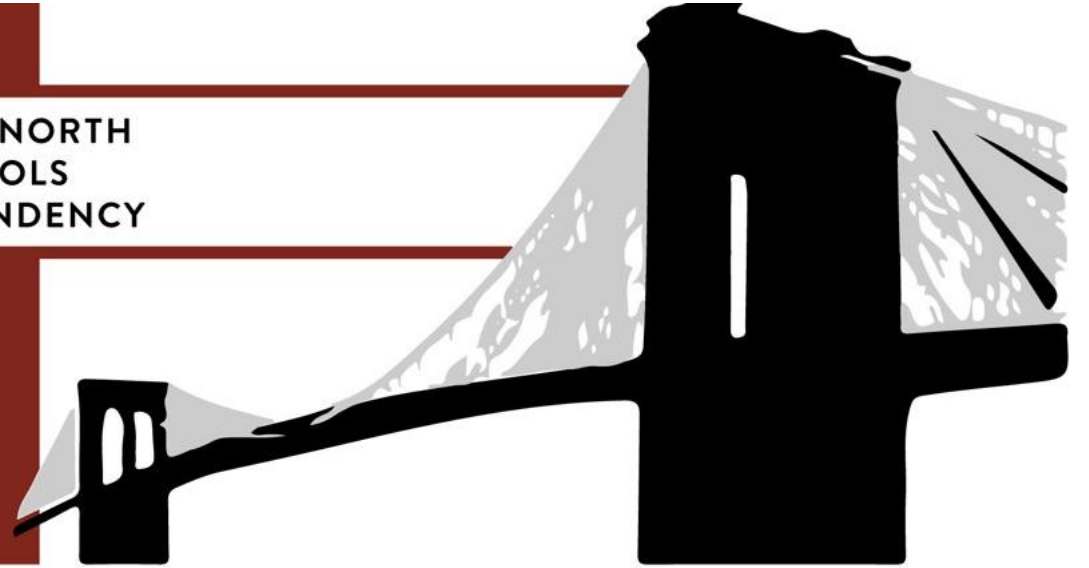

District Goals – SY2022-23



GOAL 1

By June 2023, 100% of BKNHS will partner with industries to offer career pathways, authentic work-based learning experiences, and career-connected learning informed by student voice and choice, where students are ignited by rigorous, dynamic hands-on experiences in 21st century classrooms, that support them in the pursuit of their passions and goals.



GOAL 2

By June 2023, all BKNHS will engage students in culturally responsive and sustaining, standards-aligned instruction, integrating highly impactful literacy and SEL practices, whereby 100% of our students will graduate, and improve their college readiness by 10%.



GOAL 3

By June 2023, all BKNHS will create or expand their parent engagement plans to increase family involvement in our schools through collaboration and partnership with community stakeholders, empowering parents to be co-decision-makers and best advocates for their children's learning needs in our reimagined communities.



GOAL 4

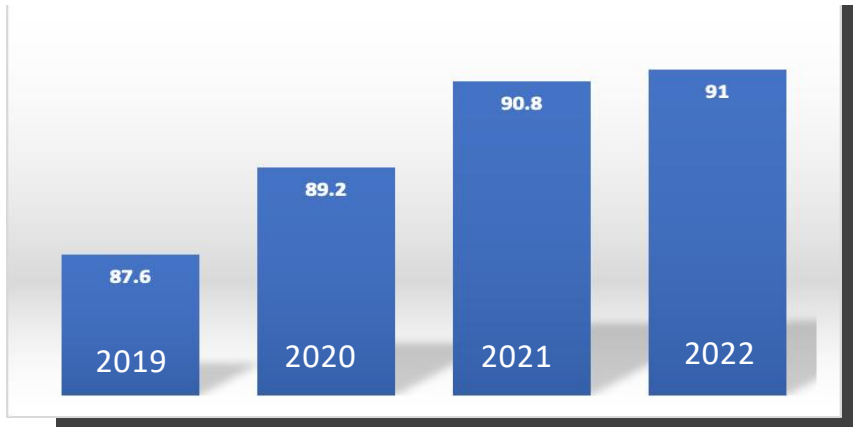
By June 2023, the BKNHS district chronic absenteeism rate will decrease by 5%, while overall attendance will increase by 5%, resulting from an effective and supportive attendance management system that involves school partners, structures for data monitoring and analysis, evaluation and assessment, and opportunities for meaningful stakeholder engagement.

4-Year Graduation as of June 2022

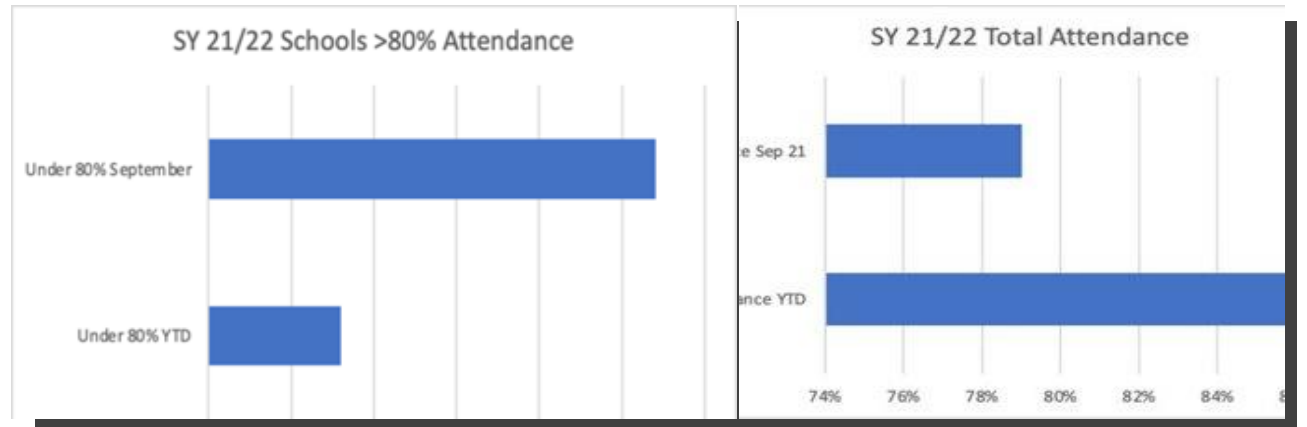
In spite of the COVID epidemic, Brooklyn North High Schools under Supt Ross's leadership have consistently supported more and more students to graduate. **As a result, as measured by NYSED accountability, ALL 47 of our schools have achieved "good standing" status!**



Attendance as of June 2022

40 of our 47 schools were above 80% YTD
 +7 percentage points (79% Sep to 86% Jun)
 38% of students were **chronically absent**

As of 3/31/23, ALL 47 schools are above 80%!

Power at its best is love implementing the demands of justice, and justice at its best is love correcting everything that stands against love." (Martin Luther King Jr., 1967).

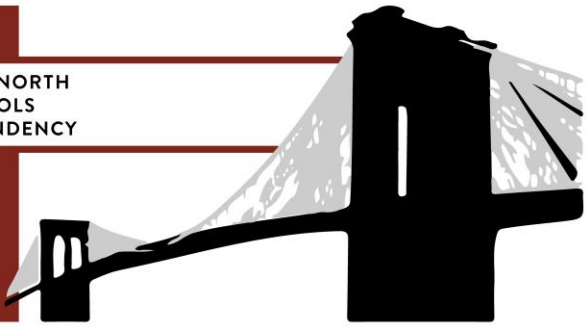
All our work in the Brooklyn North High School Superintendency align with the framework of The Pedagogy of Critical Love.

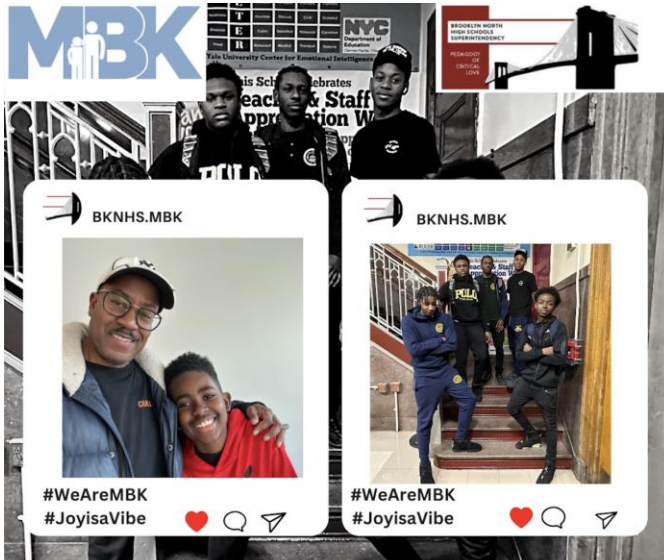

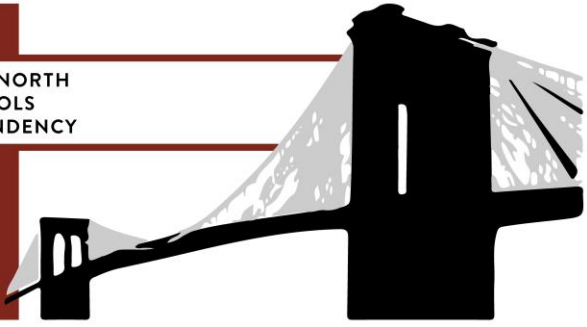

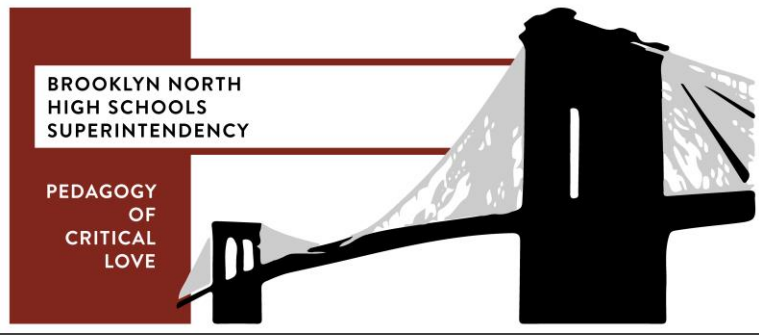

Student Voice Leadership Event

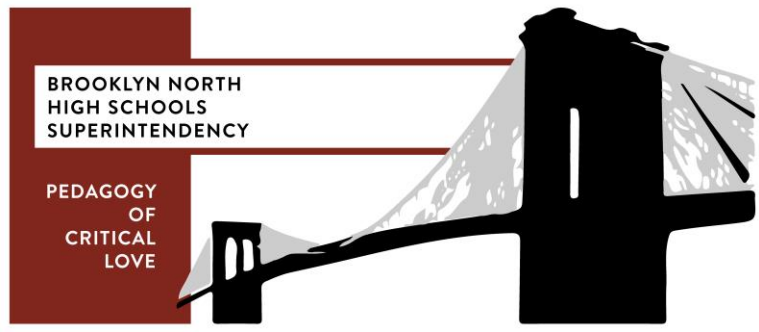
Student leaders collaborated and networked with their peers from across the city. BKNHS students participated in student-led workshops aimed at elevating and centering student voice in NYC public schools.
