District Vision

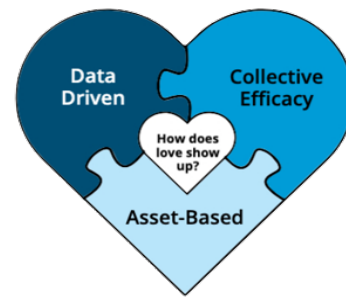

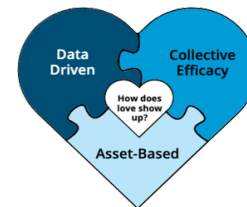
Goal 4:

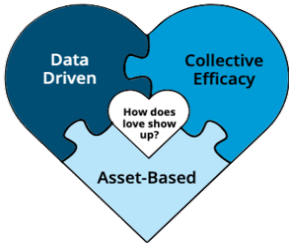
District Priority: Attendance & Chronic Absenteeism



School-based Attendance Teams
Beginning in January, the district is guiding our SBATs to engage in a PDSA cycle where they are focusing on students who are at risk of chronic absenteeism. Driven by data, teams will identify a group of students to engage with research-based interventions, with the goal of preventing them from dropping into chronic absenteeism.



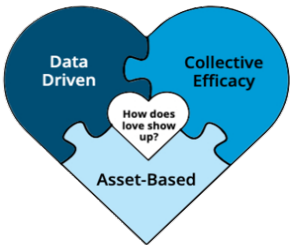

- Community service project to understand the value of giving back.

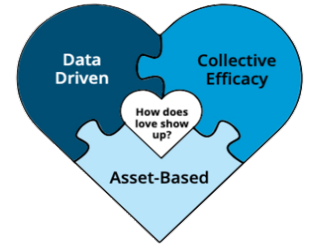

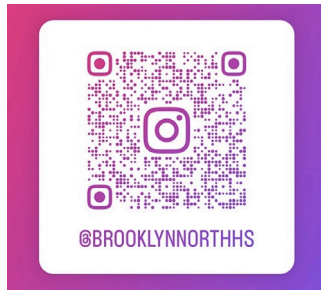
