









There was a slight increase in exams taken and in qualifying scores with the biggest increase in qualifying scores being amongst Black and Latinx students








#### SY2023-24 Year-To-Date ELL Attendance Rate















January 2024 English Language Arts Regents Pass Rates



#### January 2024 Geometry Regents Pass Rates






# Happening in Your District


