## Goal 4:

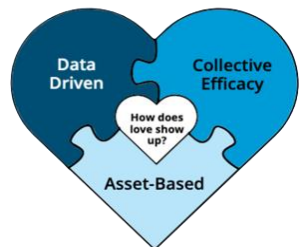

## Career Ready / Modern Youth Apprenticeship

### CybertArts Studio Academy

During freshman and sophomore year of high school, students participate in workshops, courses, and a plethora of various training sessions that prepare them to apply for apprenticeships. Students are given the opportunity to explore and discover diverse career paths in high-growth, high-wage fields. After the first two years of high school, students will be able to apply to participate in apprenticeship programs with large organizations in business operations, finance, and technology. Apprentices will continue to attend school and will earn between \$15-\$22 an hour as an entry level wage.

### In addition ...

**Park Slope Collegiate** places students as Teaching Assistants in math classrooms.

**John Jay Law** partners with law firms to provide mentors and apprenticeships.

**Sunset Park High School** is exploring partnerships for new careers in green energy – in particular, wind technology as infrastructure is being built off Brooklyn shores.
