- Special needs students struggle to walk up the stairs to their classrooms.
- When teachers need to change classrooms at the end of every school year they struggle moving heaving boxes up and down the stairs. Custodians struggle as well all year long when transporting cleaning objects like brooms and mops.
- During school events and parent/teacher conferences, parents with small children in strollers have to leave the strollers on the 1st floor because they can't carry them up the stairs. Parents with mobility issues struggle to go up the stairs to meet their children's teachers.
- They tried putting this project on the Participatory Budget but were told that this project will cost too much money.
- CEC15 members agreed that this is very important issue for all schools in New York City.

3. Review/Finalize CEC15 Requests for SCA

- CEC15 President Camille Casaretti sent the first draft of the list to Department of Facilities. Joseph Lazarus, Director of Facilities, Brooklyn North, sent back the list marking everything that should be sent to the Department of Facilities. He also highlighted what should definitely be sent to SCA.
- Small issues usually are handled by custodians. Repairs are usually handled by the Department of Facilities. Something new to the school, for example an elevator, should be sent to SCA.
- CEC15 members discussed which requests should be top 5 priorities.
