3. Revise Draft of Resolution on Charters in District 15

- New York State Charter Schools Act of 1998 §2851 and § 2852 was used to draft this resolution.
- This resolution will be the framing policy that CEC15 will use to evaluate new charter schools coming to the district.
- A request for teacher certification should be added to the resolution.
- Charters must service the district they're in. Charters servicing students from a different district stress
 the resources of to the district. Charters in overcrowded D15 areas should have mostly D15 students
 attending the school. This request will be added to the resolution.
- The committee would like to have a more sound understanding on how SUNY measures charter schools.

4. Draft of Resolution to Oppose Future Increase in Charter Cap

- Antonia Ferraro would like to draft a resolution to Oppose Future Increase in Charter Cap.
- The number of charter capacity is 460. There are currently 320 charter schools in the State of New York. The City of New York has 249 Charter schools:
 - Brooklyn 96 charter schools and 11 more were just approved in October.
