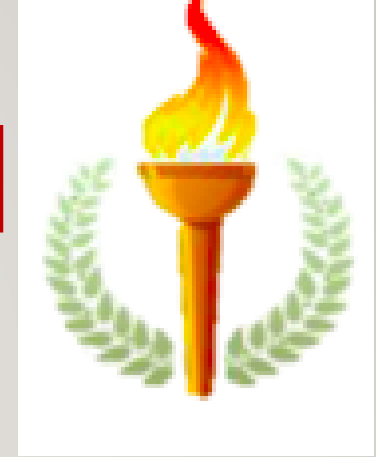

SCHOOLS CURRENTLY IMPACTED BY COVID CLOSURES

- **ONLY SCHOOLS IN THE RED ZONE ARE CURRENTLY STILL CLOSED.**
 - **DISTRICT 15 HAS ONE SCHOOL IN THE RED ZONE: PS 131**
 - **ALL OF THE OTHER SEVEN D15 SCHOOLS RE-OPENED ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2020**
 - **PS 24** **PS 230**
 - **PS 94** **PS 896**
 - **PS 130** **MS 839**
 - **PS 169**

REPROGRAMMING FOR THE END OF THE FIRST QUARTER

- **Monday, November 2 – Sunday, November 15: Blended Learning Opt-In Window for Families**
 - Families requesting to change from 100% remote to blended learning should complete and submit the [Learning Preference survey](#) during this window.
 - Schools will be able to review individual students' updated learning preference on a rolling basis during this window.
 - During this time, Superintendents, Executive Superintendents and Central DOE will begin supporting schools to ensure as many students as possible are accommodated for blended learning.
- **Weeks of November 30 & December 7: Students Begin In-Person Learning**

GRADING POLICIES

Grades 3K and PK do not receive grades.

Grades K-5: Schools select pre-approved grading scale, most use 1-4 performance levels.

- o Students would receive “needs improvement” in place of 1 and 2.
- o Any guardian who would like to replace 3 or 4 with an “MT” can make that request to school.

Grades 6-8: Schools select grading scale, most use numeric scales. “Course in progress” (NX) mark in place of failing marks. Guardian choice of replacing a passing mark with Pass.

Grades 9-12: Schools select grading scale, most use numeric scales. Incomplete mark (NX) in place of failing marks. Guardian choice of replacing a passing mark with CR.
