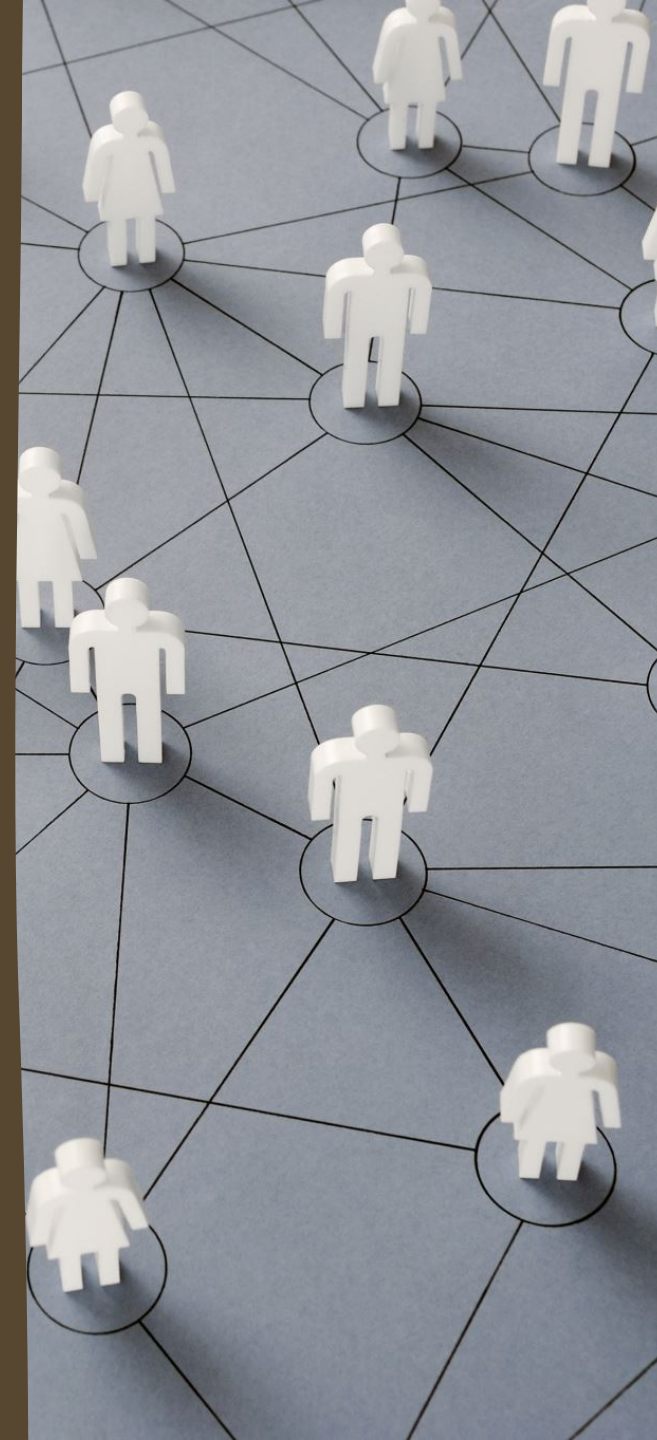

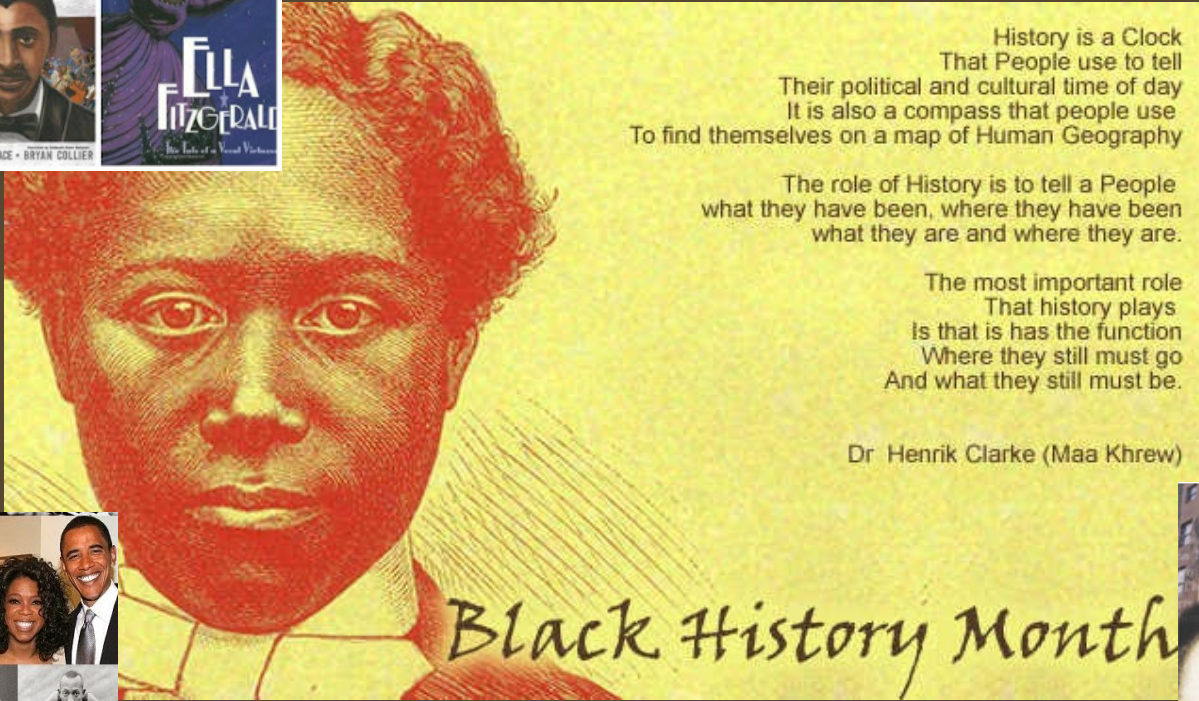

To find themselves on a map of Human Geography

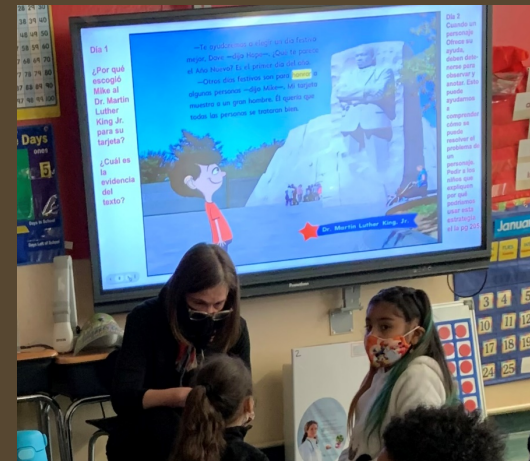
The role of History is to tell a People
