What does it mean that our schools might rezone?

District 15 elementary schools are currently zoned. This means children living within a specified area around each school are given priority to attend that school. In our area of District 15, some schools are over-crowded while others have room for more students. There are racial and socio-economic disparities across the schools. And, PS 32 is about to open a new building addition that adds 436 seats for students. This project gives local community members a chance to talk with each other and to shape recommendations for school zoning in our area, including the possibility of one shared zone. We have the opportunity to make changes to help make our part of District 15 more equitable.
