Research surrounding a project based learning foundation is currently in process to support a possible resolution. Next meeting TBA.
Equity and Language Access - Working through the logistics of the meeting structure for participants who require interpretation during the first meeting. CM Qingxia Zhu and CM Angelica Jadunandan attended a Rise Up event and Zhu felt encouraged to hold a less formal monthly event for the community to voice their concerns and learn about different resources.
