Thank you for purchasing Acclaim Audio's ESION product, the Next Generation in Audio Tools.

Note: The ESION installation can be performed without an iLOK account, however, to use ESION, an iLOK account must be present and an ESION license deposited into the account.

To install your ESION product, click the installer you purchased on the store.

ESION LEVELER

- ESIONleveler_Installer_Win.exe
- ESIONleveler_Installer_SiliconMac.dmg or
- ESIONleveler_Installer_IntelMac.dmg

ESION RESTORE

- ESIONrestore_Installer_Win.exe
- ESIONrestore_Installer_SiliconMac.dmg or
- ESIONrestore_Installer_IntelMac.dmg

ESION STUDIO

- ESIONstudio_Installer_Win.exe
- ESIONstudio_Installer_SiliconMac.dmg or
- ESIONstudio_Installer_IntelMac.dmg

For the Windows installer simply open the installer executable (.exe) and follow the installation prompts.

Both the Intel and Silicon Mac installers once opened contain the User Guide, Readme and the installer package (.pkg). Open the .pkg file and the installer will guide you through the installation process.

If this is your first Acclaim Audio product, the total install time will be longer since approximately 5GB must be downloaded and installed. All subsequent product installs will be much faster because the downloads are much smaller.

Technical notes

- 1) ESION performs all processing using a 64-bit audio engine.
- 2) ESION typically requires approximately 1GB of memory be available for processing.
- 3) ESION creates between four and eight temporary work files during processing. Once processing concludes the temporary files are removed.
- 4) The temporary work files are larger than the input file and as such, please plan for sufficient disk space availability on the drive you designate to house the temporary "work" files.

The following table illustrates the approximate temporary disk space required for processing.

Input file duration	Disk Space
5 minutes	500 MB
15 minutes	1.5 GB
30 minutes	3 GB
1 hour	6 GB
2 hours	11 GB

Additional notes

For optimal performance it is suggested the temporary work files be placed on an SSD drive (*see the User Guide for instructions on how to change the location of the temporary work files*).
