We decided to remember what is "I love you" in our mother tongues. And we got riched of "te quiero", "ma armastan sind", "amo-te" and "kocham cje".

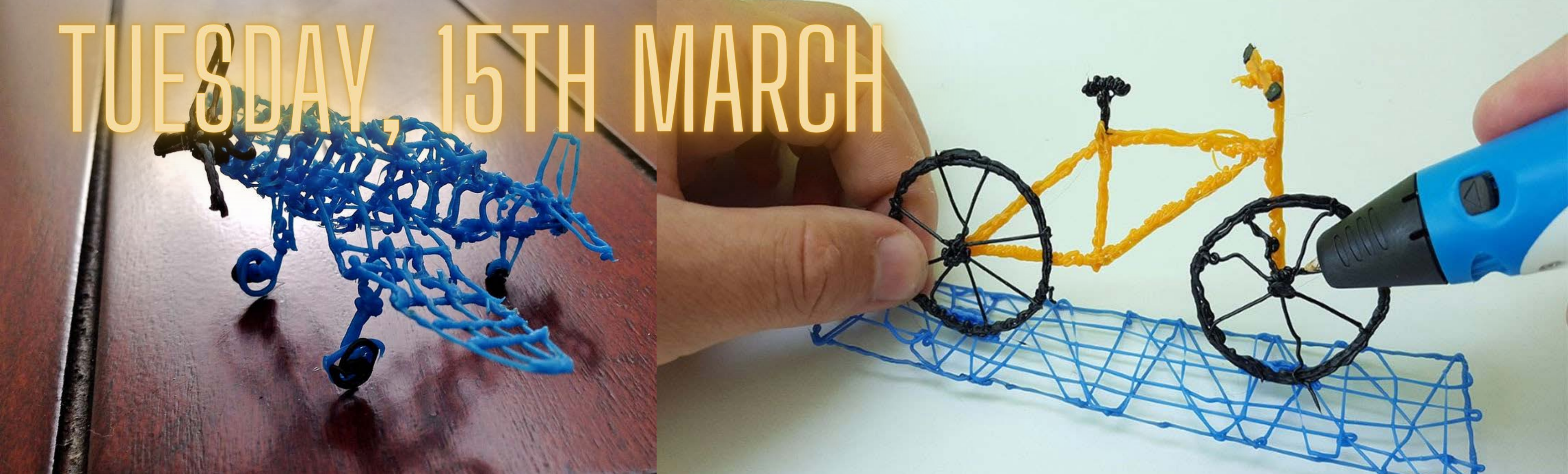

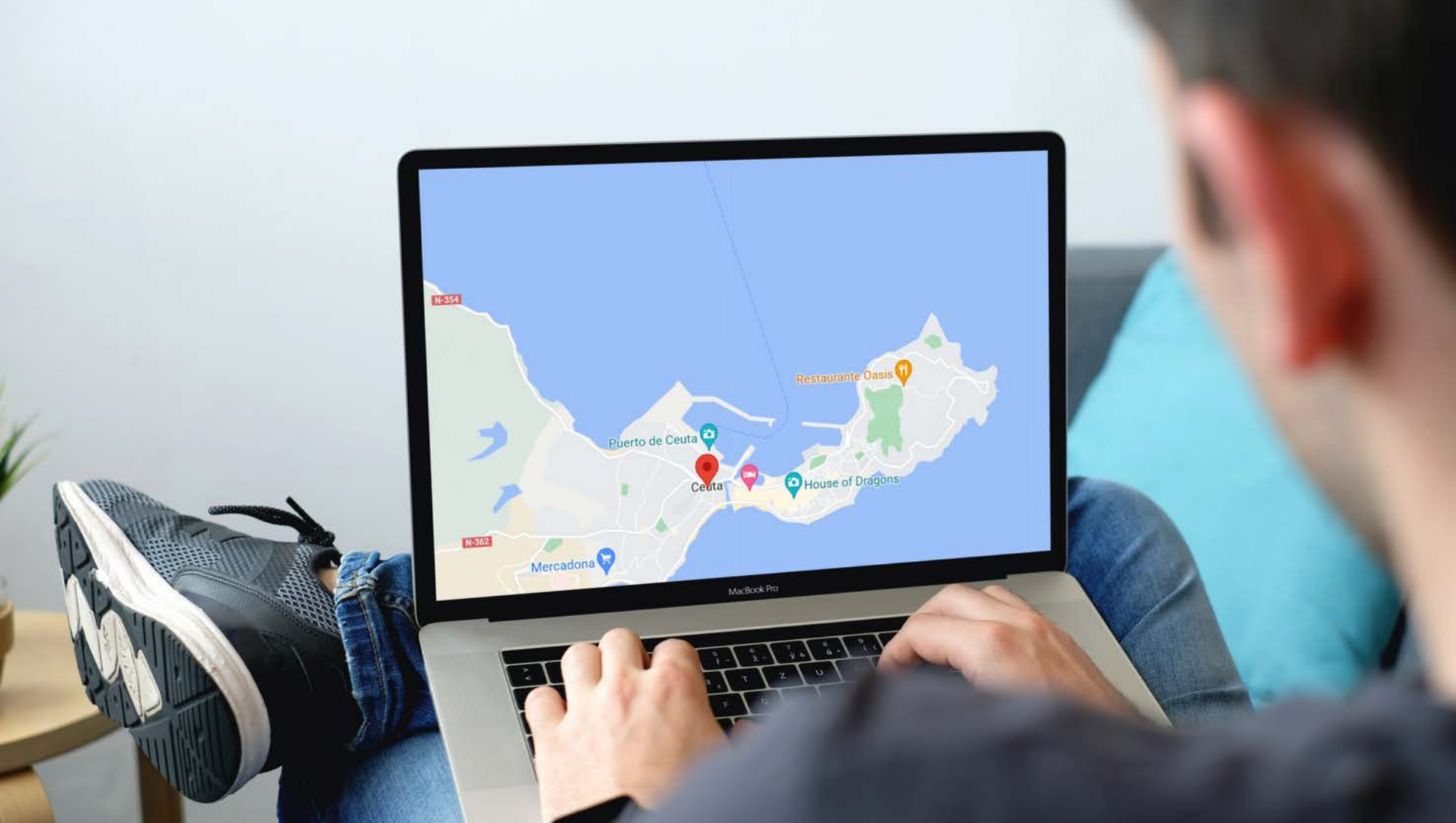
**After this feast we

After that we went to Torre de Aranguren where we had a snack and watched military training.

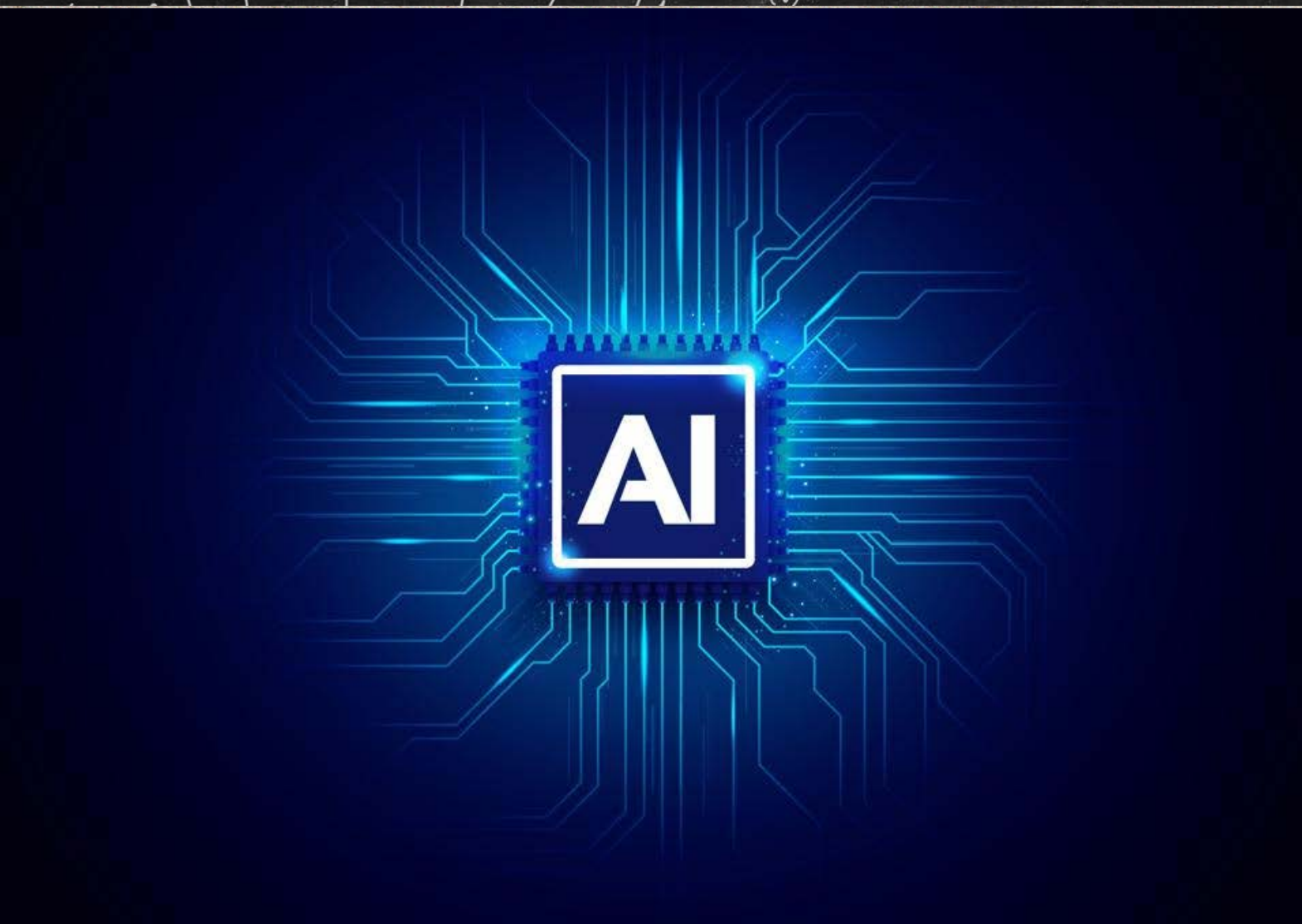
