OVEN 375°F, 190°C, Reg 5, near top
25-30 mins (ovens may vary)

Wine

- Home made fruit or vegetable wine (NO KITS or CONCENTRATES) to be presented in clear wine bottles with flanged cork. Labelled clearly with main ingredient and whether sweet or dry, using a small label placed about 1" above base of bottle.*

'The Master Gardener'

- 66 A display of vegetables, fruit and flowers containing: An exhibit of vegetables - any one class from 14-35; An exhibit of fruit – any one class from 39-41; A vase of flowers – any one class 45-50. Table space provided – 18" wide x 24" deep. A backdrop 24" in height may be incorporated. Exhibitors must cover space provided (and any backdrop) with black cloth or similar material.
