


Lunch Deliveries

- 1 package Spiral Pasta Noodles
- 1 Head of Broccoli Crowns or Florets
- 1 package of Mini-Pepperoni
- 1 Jar Sliced Kalamata Olives
- 1 package of Sun-Dried Tomatoes
- 1 package of Pine nuts (optional due to allergies, If you prefer try Almond slivers- no skin or glazed walnuts <u>with-out</u> Italian dressing.)
- 1 Bottle Italian or Balsamic Salad Dressing
- 1 package of Cubed Cheese Pepper Jack, or Colby, or Extra Sharp Cheese
- 1 package of Feta Cheese Crumbles
- Add diced Colored Bell Peppers and/or onion

Parmesan cheese: Sprinkle to Taste

Pepper to Taste (Optional)

You may omit anything from this Ingredients list...

1st Cook Paste as directed on package drain the water off the Pasta, set aside to cool, you may throw in Broccoli together cook them at same time remove before over cooking the florets/crowns.

Put all ingredients together into cooled pasta with dressing except cheeses and Feta Crumbles add toward the end before serving otherwise they will melt together.
