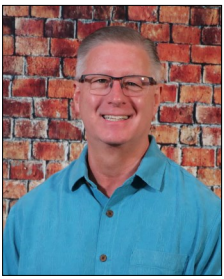

## Prism Journey Update

The Vision Realization Committee held our first meeting with Master's Plan Church Design & Construction on April 1, 2026. During this five-hour meeting, we spent significant time discussing the ministry needs of our church and how those needs connect with the vision and goals of our Prism Journey Future Story.

A major focus of the discussion centered on the flow of people throughout our campus and ways those areas can be improved to better serve our church family and guests. We also talked extensively about creating a more welcoming environment for new families, including ways to help them feel more comfortable, connected, and secure when they visit our campus.

Following that initial meeting, Master's Plan began developing ideas and concepts designed to align with and support the Prism Journey Vision. 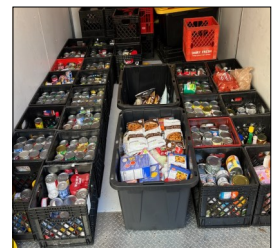

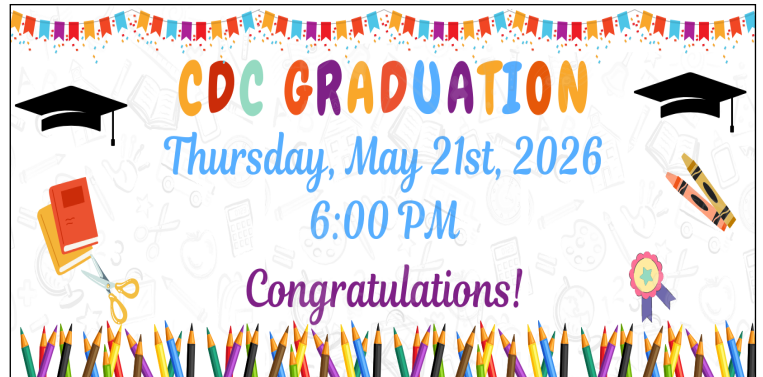
