Pre-requisites: To qualify for the training, the student must be able to provide the following evidence:

- Over 18 years of age (Copy of drivers licence);
- Dangerous Goods Security Card (DGSC), Security Sensitive Ammonium Nitrate (SSAN) clearance, Explosives Security Clearance (QLD);
- Currently or recent employment in a blast crew or support role.

The course may be attended by personnel employed in the quarrying, mining, or construction industry who wish to gain an insight into drilling and blasting practices.
