The Statement of Attainment will enable the student to demonstrate competency to a National VET level for Magazine Keeping.

Pre-requisites: To qualify for the training, the student must be able to provide the following evidence:

- Over 18 years of age (Copy of drivers licence);
- Dangerous Goods Security Card (DGSC) or Security Sensitive Ammonium Nitrate (SSAN) clearance;
- Unique Student Identifier number (USI);
- 3 months prior experience working with explosives.

All communications, bookings and inquiries will be via Blast It Global, contact details are on the last page.

The course may be attended by personnel employed in the quarrying, mining or construction industry, who are wishing to gain an insight into drilling and blasting practices. Personnel not wishing to gain the qualifications of Open Cut Shotfirers licence/permit, should select the "Require training for Drill & Blast General Knowledge (No qualification)" box.

Course Contents: The Magazine Keeper Course will combine classroom learning with workshops to develop skills, along with open book tests to assess students' understanding of topics, covered during the course.
