What is Theraplay?

Theraplay is a dyadic child and family therapy approach developed over 50 years ago and practiced around the world. This dyadic approach helps families and children improve attachment and improve the resilience of children. Practitioners who have become Theraplay practitioners guide the parents and child through challenging and playful activities that improve parents ability to regulate their child's behavior and communicate love, and safety to their child. This approach also provides an opportunity for parents to learn help their child increase their social engagement, expand arousal regulation, and develop positive self esteem for both the parent and child.

To provide Theraplay as a clinical practitioner, Therapy Institute provides training to assist in becoming efficient in implementation in this approach from young children up to adolescents. NDAPT will be providing a great opportunity to expand your knowledge and play therapy skills by offering level 1 Theraplay training for you to implement in your practice.
