O Book a direct flight if possible (fewer layovers = less stress).

Reserve a bassinet seat (available on some long-haul flights).	
Pack a diaper bag with all essentials (see below).	
O Download kids' shows, white noise, or soothing music.	
O Arrange transportation (will you need a car seat at your destination?).	
O Bring necessary travel documents (passports, birth certificates if needed).

O Diapers & Wipes (enough for the trip + extra in case of delays).	
O Changing pad (for changing in small airplane bathrooms).	
O Baby formula/breast milk (TSA allows larger amounts of liquids for babies).	
O Bottles/sippy cups (pre-fill with water if allowed).	
O Snacks & baby food (easy-to-eat, non-messy options).	
O Pacifiers or teething toys (helps with ear pressure).	
O Extra clothes (for baby & yourself in case of spills).	
O Blanket/swaddle (for warmth and comfort). Providing helping hands to ensure

O Plastic bags (for dirty diapers or soiled clothes).	
O Hand sanitizer & disinfecting wipes (for surfaces & hands).

□ Checked Luggage Essentials	
O Car seat (check for free or use on board if FAA-a	pproved).
O Collapsible stroller (some airlines allow gate-checking).	
O More diapers & wipes (enough for the entire trip).	
O Baby-friendly detergent (for washing clothes on longer trips).	
O Baby monitor (if staying in a hotel or Airbnb).	
O First aid kit (baby fever meds, thermometer, bar	nd-aids).
At the Airport & During the Flight	
Arrive early to allow extra time for security & boarding.	
Use a baby carrier for security screening (strollers often need extra checks).	

O Feed during takeoff & landing (breastfeeding, bottle, or pacifier helps with ear pressure).

Keep baby entertained (toys, books, or screen time if needed).Ask for help—flight attendants can warm bottles or assist.
