Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 1. The tournament starts promptly at 8am, Saturday, April 26, 2025. This is an individual surf fishing tournament only. No help, except for gaffing. Your feet must be in the sand. You must fish with a rod and reel. No nets. Boundaries are from North Beach at Oregon Inlet to South Beach of Ocracoke.
- 2. All tournament packets will be available for pick up at the Cape Hatteras Secondary School (Cape Hatteras High School) 48576 North Carolina HWY 12 Buxton, NC 27920 on Saturday morning from 7am to 9am. Updates will be available on the 4Plus Tournament Facebook page.
 - **3.** Weigh-in will take place from 6:30 am to 8:00 am at the Cape Hatteras Secondary School on Sunday, April 27th 2025.

We will abide by the limitations of the North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries and the rules and regulations enforced by the National Park Service. 4Plus will not weigh or record any illegal fish.

All fish must be weighed and recorded by a tournament official or by a tournament designated weigh station. Any violation of tournament rules listed above may disqualify the offending fisherman.

You must register with an official at the weigh-in no later than 8am. Any discrepancies must be registered with the judges prior to the 8am cutoff. All decisions made by the three (3) judges are final.

If you weigh in a fish at one of the tackle shops be sure to retain your receipt, proof of weigh in certificate.

Please remember that any registered fish must be available for inspection at the weigh-in Sunday morning.

4. We WILL have a meeting <u>Sunday morning</u>, <u>April 27th at 8am</u> at the Cape Hatteras Secondary School. Fishing tournament winners will be announced and presented with their winnings.

Door Prizes and Raffle tickets will be drawn and handed out as well.
