Geographic inclusivity: Equitable access requires investing in infrastructure to reach rural and underserved urban areas that lack access to high-speed internet.

Affordability: Equitable broadband requires making internet services affordable for low-income households.

Digital Literacy: Equitable access involves digital literacy programs designed to help individuals navigate online space, understand cybersecurity, and utilize digital tools for personal and professional growth.

Inclusive Policy: Equitable access requires public and private policies that prioritize closing the digital divide.

Public-Private Partnerships: Equitable access requires collaboration between governments, private companies, and non-profits to leverage the different resources and expertise they bring to the challenge of addressing gaps in internet availability.

Community Engagement: Equitable access requires understanding the specific needs of different communities.
