## Valid and Accepted Identifications at Security Checkpoints

- 1. State-issued driver's license or ID card
- 2. U.S. Passport (valid)
- 3. U.S. Passport Card
- 4. Green Card or Permanent Resident Card for those users who are not U.S. citizens but do have permission
- 5. DHS Trusted Traveler Cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST) used to facilitate border crossings
- U.S. Department of Defense ID (including IDs issued to dependents)
- 7. Border Crossing Card (for those who travel frequently between the U.S. and Mexico)
- 8. An acceptable photo ID issued by a federally recognized tribal nation/Indian tribe, including Enhanced Tribal Cards (ETCs).
- 9. HSPD-12 PIV Card (from government agencies)
- 10. Passport issued by a foreign government
- Canadian Provincial Driver's License or Indian and Northern Affairs Canada Card
- 12. Transportation Worker Identification Credential
- 13. U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Employment Authorization Card (I-766)
- 14. U.S. Merchant Mariner Credential
- 15. Veterans Health Identification Card (VHIC)
