

## Valid and Accepted Identifications at Security Checkpoints

1. State-issued driver's license or ID card
2. U.S. Passport (valid)
3. U.S. Passport Card
4. Green Card or Permanent Resident Card for those users who are not U.S. citizens but do have permission
5. DHS Trusted Traveler Cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST) used to facilitate border crossings
6. U.S. Department of Defense ID (including IDs issued to dependents)
7. Border Crossing Card (for those who travel frequently between the U.S. and Mexico)
8. An acceptable photo ID issued by a federally recognized tribal nation/Indian tribe, including Enhanced Tribal Cards (ETCs).
9. HSPD-12 PIV Card (from government agencies)
10. Passport issued by a foreign government
11. Canadian Provincial Driver's License or Indian and Northern Affairs Canada Card
12. Transportation Worker Identification Credential
13. U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Employment Authorization Card (I-766)
14. U.S. Merchant Mariner Credential
15. Veterans Health Identification Card (VHIC)
