
A few of quick reminders:

The Perfect Time to Step Outside and Spruce Up Your Outdoor Spaces!

Take advantage of the season to refresh and tidy up your patios and entryways—it's a great way to enjoy the outdoors and enhance our community's charm!

Some important rules to know- To keep our community safe, beautiful, and enjoyable for everyone, please take a moment to review these important rules and reminders. Following these guidelines ensures a better quality of life for all residents and protects our shared investment.

- **Grill Safety Reminder** Per the Germantown Ordinance, all grills must be used at least 10' away from the building. This is an important safety measure designed to protect you, your neighbors, and the property.
- **Save Money & Stay Safe**: Free Smoke Alarm Installation- The Germantown Fire Dept. has a program, and they will install 2 **smoke alarms with a 10-year battery free of charge** in your home, which means no more frequent battery changes and better long-term protection for your home. Call 751-7600 to schedule this service.
- ♦ Hot Water Heater Safety Reminder- If you change your hot water heater, please be sure to consult your plumber about installing a proper electrical disconnect and replace any outdated or damaged plugs, cord, or wiring that could pose a fire hazard.
- **Patio Maintenance** Trees planted in patio areas may cause damage to building structures and fences. If you have trees on your patio, please **trim them back** to prevent interference or property damage.
- **Dryer vents and fireplaces** For your safety and that of your neighbors, **dryer vents and fireplaces must be cleaned annually**. This helps prevent fire hazards and improves system efficiency.
- **WHYAC System Maintenance**-With seasonal changes approaching, now is the time to **service your HVAC systems**.
- Architectural Review Required: Any changes to the exterior of your unit, including windows, doors, or other structural updates, require prior approval from the board. Submit your Architectural Review request through the AppFolio portal. Unauthorized changes may result in fines, violations, or required removal.
- Pet Etiquette- Please pick up after your pets—pet waste spreads disease and attracts rodents.

 Also, remember: All pets must be leashed when outside your unit. This is for the safety and comfort of everyone in the community.
