To all Local 100 Lodge Presidents and Recording Secretaries.

This is a follow up notice to the one sent by Local 100 Local, dated September 01, 2025.

*Note: This Local 100 election call is for the Office of President Local 100 only. This notice conforms with Sections 2 and 3 of Local 100's By-Laws. A copy of the by-laws, this election call, and extra nomination forms can be found at, www.uniforlocal100.com

President of Local 100

- Election of Local 100 Officers shall be held triennially beginning in 1996.
- Notices shall go out to each Lodge 4 months prior to the election year stating that the office of President Local 100 shall be declared open for nomination October 1^{st,} 2025. Attached to this notice is a nomination form for the office of President Local 100. All completed nomination forms for the office of President, must be received by **registered mail** by the Chairman of the election committee **by 0001 November 1st prior to the election year** to 1376 Grant Avenue #110, Winnipeg Manitoba, R3M3Y4. Nomination forms must be signed by two (2) Local 100 members in good standing and by the nominee.
- Each candidate **may submit their printed election information** with their nomination papers, such printed information to be no more than one single spaced 8"x 11" page.

If after the nomination process is completed and an election is to take place, the following will be the voting procedure.

- -For the office of President, the election committee shall cause a ballot to be **electronically sent** to each Local 100 member in good standing no later than December 1st (2025). This will be done using the members **personal email** as supplied to Local 100.Ballots must be returned electronically no later than January 1st (2026). Counting of ballots shall begin no later than **January 6th 2026**, and the Local 100 President notified forthwith of the final election results. Simply voting will be the company sending out, receiving, and counting all electronic ballots, with results sent to the Local 100 Election Committee.
- -If a run off election is required dates shall be set by the Election Committee.
- Electronic voting is done securely and only the member will know how she/he voted.

Please ensure all members in your Lodge see this notice.
