Subject: Inspection and Verification of Minimum Construction Standards for Tree Farm Subdivision Located on Tree Farm Road (SR 1199)

Dear Mr. O'Neal:

This is to advise that the above-mentioned subject has been constructed in accordance with the North Carolina Department of Transportation Minimum Construction Standards for Subdivision Roads. District personnel, B.C. Turner II, Transportation Technician III, inspected the project and verified that the Minimum Construction Standards were met.

This approval pertains to initial construction only and should not be interpret as acceptance of the roads to the State Maintenance System.

Once the minimum housing requirements have been met and the roads are in an acceptable state of maintenance, the property owners may petition the State for addition. Masonry mailboxes, plastic pipe, shrubbery, or other structures are not allowed within the right-of-way. Placement of these items within the right-of-way will result in the road being ineligible for State maintenance.
