NAWSA USE OF DOMESTIC SEMEN FORM



The NAWSA does not delineate between the use of live cover and AI to produce

progeny. The domestic semen used must be from a registered NAWSA ram for progeny to be eligible for registration with the NAWSA. Breeders are free to collect and use semen from rams they own. As of January 2021. this form must be submitted by the owner of the collected ram prior to progeny submitted by anyone other than the owner of the ram. Rams collected prior to 1/01/2021 do not have to comply with photo requirements if ram is deceased or no longer available.

The NAWSA will maintain a list of domestic semen collected for sale or use by breeders other than the owner of record. This form must be on file with the NAWSA prior to the registration of any progeny registered by any member **<u>other</u>** than the owner of the ram.
