

## NAWSA RECOGNITION OF IMPORTED SEMEN

As of Jan 1, 2021, importers of purebred registered Wensleydale semen that is not already registered with the NAWSA must submit this form for registering with the NAWSA prior to any offspring being entered into the NAWSA Registry.

Requirements for recognition for collected rams:

- 1. Proof of registration with the WLSBA Wensleydale Longwool Sheep Breeders (UK)
- 2. Proof of RR at codon 171
- 3. Pictures including front and side view and visible ear tags
- 4. DNA profile to go into a NAWSA library for future members to utilize
- 5. Copy of the import form
- 6. Copy of pedigree
- 7. Optional: Written description or history on this ram (eg., show results etc)

Once all information is submitted, the ram will receive a NAWSA # and be kept on the approved list of eligible semen to be used to produce NAWSA registered offspring. The semen will carry 100% when calculating blood percentage.
