PASSING OF A CHAMPION PADDLER, MOVER-AND-A-SHAKER

Long-time Marathon paddler Fred Heese passed away Feb 28 from colon cancer in his 81st year. Fred was an Olympi- every day at the YMCA, near an (Tokyo '64) in the C2. He was a dedicated paddler all of his life. He had a long career in Fred Heese authored "Canoe marathon canoe racing (one of Racing" a book mostly about Canada's best) mostly with Stan Machacek, after his sprint published in the mid-1970s career (with Cartierville, West Rouge, Mississauga, '64 Olympic team – 7th place).

Fred represented Canada at Canoe Marathon World Championships with Mike Devine in his late 40s. He eventually turned to dragon boat and represented Canada at several world championships as a paddler and a coach. He coached Team Canada to Dragon Boat World Championship gold recruiting many former national team sprint canoeists, like Larry Cain, Doug Tutty, etc. and founded the Toronto Dragon


Boat Festival. He paddled daily at his cottage in the summers and worked out his home in Westmount, Quebec.


His commemorative funeral will be webcast on Saturday, March 23, 2024 from 3:40 PM EDT to 5:20 PM EDT.

New York Paddle Racing Association adopts GRB Concept canoe design into the C1 class

In some exciting news for Marathon canoe racing the New York Paddle Racing Association has adopted the GRB Concept canoe design into the CI class. <u>https://</u> www.nypra.org/boat-specs

CI - Open

This class is for racing canoes that fit the 4x32. Boats are to be a maximum length of 186" and they should measure at least 32" wide at the 4-inch waterline.

As of the 2024 season, NYPRA is allowing the GRB Concept to participate in this class. It is the position of the NYPRA that while it's slower at some things and faster in others, it all balances out, and the Concept is cheaper to make and might help draw people into the sport.


In addition to being less costly to build, the boat is easier to transport and is popular in international marathon communities. A longer term benefit may be more participation in North American Marathon paddle races.



Another race may replace La Classique, maybe

La Classique internationelle de canots de la mauricie, AKA "Shawinigan" pro boat and Rabaska canoe race, held since 1934, has long been described as Canada's "richest" canoe race but fell on hard times recently. In January, citing a \$450,000 debt, the corporation's directors announced the race could not run in 2024 but a committee of dedicated paddlers immediately took up the challenge of running an event on Labour Day weekend.
