

ASPHALT PAVER

Projects will be primarily residential work such as driveways, although some roadway patching and trail paving are also a part of our services. Strong, organization, communication, and customer service skills are a must.

JOB PREREQUISITES

Qualified applicants must have a minimum of one year of hands-on paving experience including:

- Site preparation including drainage, grading, shooting elevations, and base preparation
- Operation of asphalt paving equipment such as a paver, roller and skidsteer
- Ability to use various asphalt hand tools such as an asphalt lute and rake
- Experience with driveway paving

Applicants must also meet the following requirements:

- Be able to legally work in the United States
- Be willing to assist with other types of construction when needed
- Be self-motivated, positive, and willing to perform multiple job tasks as needed
- Be able to show a professional demeanor on every jobsite
- Be able to take instruction and follow safety rules
- Be able to lift at least 80 pounds, bend, squat, and twist
- Be able to work outdoors in both hot and cold weather and varying weather conditions

Not required, but a plus:

- Ability to use mini excavator
- Snow removal experience (plow and spreader)

JOB DUTY DESCRIPTION

- Organize tools and materials needed to complete the project and assist with loading trucks and trailers.
- Greet client.
- Review project instructions with the foreman.
- Confirm layout, elevations, measurements and locations of all public and private utilities.
- Ensure that you have the proper safety equipment for the day's tasks. Review job specific safety procedures.
- Use hand and power tools.
- The asphalt paver will perform tasks such as demo, excavation, grading, base installation, asphalt installation, equipment operation, job-site cleanup, and various other tasks related to installing asphalt.
- Address any concerns that develop and confirm any changes with the foreman prior to execution.
- Make sure tools are clean and all items are neatly loaded onto the truck.
- Before leaving the jobsite, review completed work with the foreman, address any concerns, and, if needed, review the work plan for the following day with the foreman.
- On days when the weather is not conducive to construction, complete other maintenance tasks at the construction yard such as organizing tools and materials, maintaining equipment, etc.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Attend safety and educational seminars.
- Provide suggestions and collaborate to improve construction practices, safety procedures, and customer service.
- Other duties as specified by the project manager and foreman.
- Seasonal snow removal duties such as plowing and sanding (driver's license and clean driving record required to participate).
