Baptism is also a sign and seal of the covenant of grace, of ingrafting into Christ, of regeneration, of forgiveness of sins, and of surrender to God through Jesus Christ to walk in newness of life. By Christ's own appointment, this sacrament is to be continued in His church until the end of the age... Not only those who personally profess faith in and obedience to Christ, but also the infants of one or both believing parents are to be baptized... The sacrament of baptism is to be administered only once to any person.**
