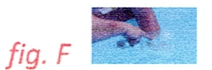


Quick Set Pools



1. Locate the return feed on the wall of your pool *{fig. A}* (this is the jet where water returns from your pump back into the pool)
2. unscrew the "O" ring and directional jet from the return feed *{fig B}* put both in a safe place as you will need them on when not using the magic pool filter
3. Take the included cap and male connector attachment and screw it onto the top of the filter hand tight *{fig. C}* your Magic Pool Filter is ready to use.
4. Take the quick set pool attachment with the taped end *{fig. D}* and push the taped end into the small opening until it is snug *{fig. E}*
5. Now take the Magic Pool Filter and submerge it under the water (bubbles will be created as the air is replaced) continue until bubbles stop and all the air is out *(fig F)*
6. Keeping the filter submerged and with the cap and male connector attachments secured to the filter, screw the male connector into the threaded end of the quick set pool attachment tighten ONLY HAND TIGHT. *{fig. G}*
7. The filter is now ready to operate MAKE SURE THE SIDE LABELED "THIS SIDE UP" IS AT THE TOP then simply turn on the pump water will flow through the pump and out through The Magic Pool Filter filtering system and return cleaner water into the pool (the filter may burb and spit some air and water sometimes creating a fountain effect when first powered on this is normal and will diminish quickly)



FILTER REMOVAL / CLEANING FILTER

FILTER REMOVAL: When the pool water is clean and it is time to remove the filter or clean it. **The most important thing is the keep the filter submerged under water until you can quickly remove it from the pool** as it will drain instantly upon getting air, potentially draining the contaminates back into the pool. Unscrew the filter from the return feed keeping the filter submerged then quickly remove it from the pool to an area on the ground where it can drain out. All of the contaminates collected will drain out leaving the inside filter material with a cleaner look.

CLEANING: You can clean the filter by simply sticking the end of your garden hose into mouth of the bottle (careful not to insert too deep) and run clean water through the filter. When the water runs clean and the inside material is cleaner (will never be like new but will rinse fairly clean) it is ready to reuse as directed for up to 4 weeks. When the inside filter fibers no longer get clean enough (typically 4 weeks) it is time for a new Magic Pool Filter.

Less contaminants in the pool water means the chlorine you do put in your pool, to maintain the minimum chlorine level, will sanitize the pool water longer before more chlorine will need to be added. Therefore reducing the amount of chlorine you will need overall for the swimming season.
