

TOILET TRAINING STEP-BY-STEP

When bringing home a new puppy there are responsibilities and also time management that has to happen in the initial few weeks.

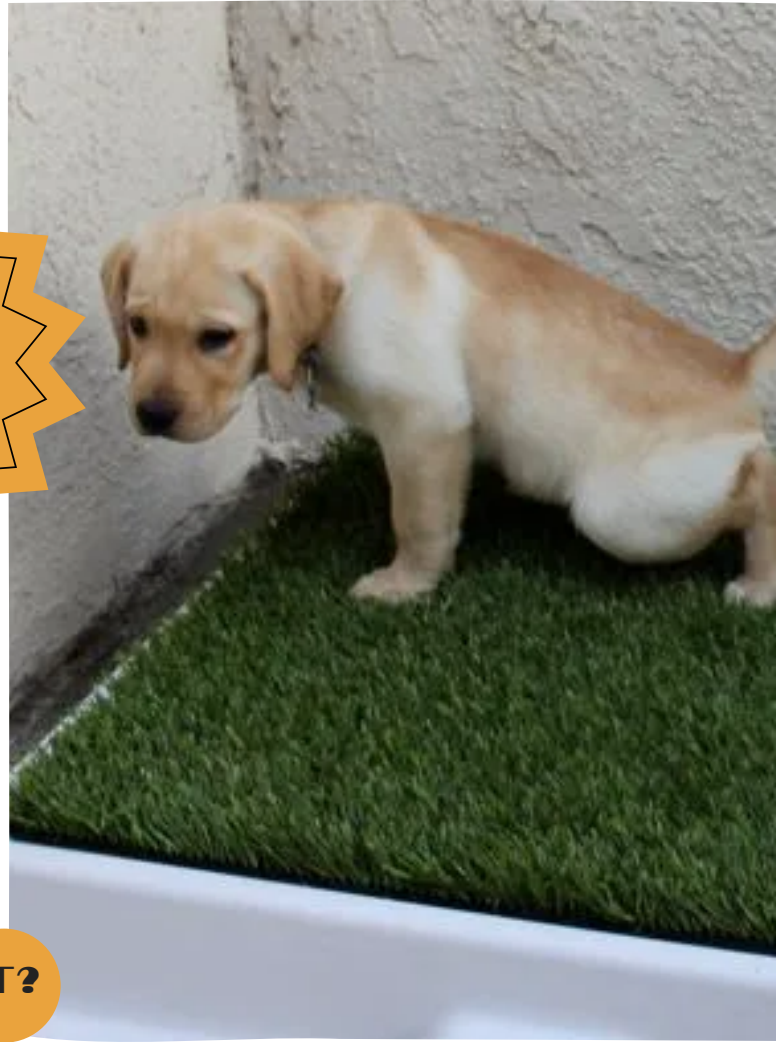
HOW DO YOU START?

Take time off when the puppy/adult dog comes home.

Try and be with your dog as much as you can to understand their pattern of peeing or pooping
Look for specific places your puppy or dog is choosing to eliminate

Write down how many times your dog has peed in one day and in what circumstances especially puppies have a very low control on their bladder.

Create a consistent schedule take your dog/puppy to a particular place when you see the signs that he would want to pee or poop now like after food, play, excitement, waking up from sleep



As your puppy/dog is ready to go downstairs start with every half an hour pee breaks even if its only for 10mins.

Set a fix schedule of meal time and play time and nap time

Get him to pee or poop before bedtime too. If pup is not eliminating try playing with him or a short walk so the bowel movements get exercised.

Start slowly putting the command like good boy/girl do susu, potty and slow praises

To get used to of a particular area you can also keep some cloth or surface like an artificial lawn that already has their pee smell which will help them associate the area.



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Be Consistent. Repeat. Be Patient



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
